Studio Grade Requirement

Master of Landscape Architecture Studio Grade Requirement

Students must achieve a minimum average of B- in the core sequence in order to enter the 7000-level studio sequence. Students who do not fulfill this requirement may be permitted to repeat the LANDARCH 6110 or LANDARCH 6120 studio. If a student still fails to meet the B- average after taking an additional 6000-level studio, they will be dismissed from the Master of Landscape Architecture program.

The option to repeat a studio is contingent on a student having met the requirements of Academic Probation. A suspension or dismissal resulting from the Academic Probation policy takes precedence over this Studio Grade Requirement policy.
